7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract**  
8 **with Melway Paving Company, Inc., for the 2023 Summit County 422 Resurfacing**  
9 **Program, in an amount not to exceed \$708,444.85, for the Engineer, and declaring an**  
10 **emergency.**

11  
12 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2022-370, which authorized  
13 the Executive to advertise, as needed, for bridge engineering and construction projects, and  
14 pavement maintenance projects, for the Engineer’s 2023 Capital Improvements Program, and  
15 federal and state funded projects, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$13,962,800.00; and

16  
17 WHEREAS, said projects were approved as part of the Capital Improvements Program  
18 for 2023-2028 by Resolution No. 2023-025; and

19  
20 WHEREAS, following the receipt and review of bids, the Executive proposes entering  
21 into a construction contract with Melway Paving Company, Inc., for the 2023 Summit County  
22 422 Resurfacing Program, in an amount not to exceed \$708,444.85; and

23  
24 WHEREAS, the work to be performed by Melway Paving Company, Inc. will consist of  
25 resurfacing various County, Copley Township, Coventry Township, and Springfield Township  
26 roads, by applying 422 Chip Seal; and

28 WHEREAS, the contract total will be broken down by political subdivision as follows  
29 with each subdivision responsible for directly paying the contractor:

- 31 County share: \$281,684.80
- 32 Copley Township: \$88,084.85
- 33 Coventry Township: \$207,836.80
- 34 Peninsula: \$36,560.25
- 35 Springfield Township: \$37,078.30; and

38 WHEREAS, following the receipt and review of bids, the Executive proposes entering  
39 into a construction contract with Melway Paving Company, Inc., for the 2023 Summit County  
40 422 Resurfacing Program, in an amount not to exceed \$708,444.85; and

42 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on April 12, 2023, awarded a  
43 construction contract with Melway Paving Company, Inc., as the lowest responsive and  
44 responsible bidder, for the 2023 Summit County 422 Resurfacing Program, in an amount not to  
45 exceed \$708,444.85, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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47 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
48 that the aforementioned construction contract with Melway Paving Company, Inc. is necessary  
49 and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

50 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio,

6 The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Melway Paving  
7 Company, Inc., for the 2023 Summit County 422 Resurfacing Program, in an amount not to  
8 exceed \$708,444.85, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said  
9 construction contract and any other necessary related documents.

11 SECTION 2

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13 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
14 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately  
15 providing a necessary construction contract for the 2023 Summit County 422 Resurfacing  
16 Program.

18 SECTION 3

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20 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
21 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
22 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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26 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
27 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
28 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,


