7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract**  
8 **with Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for community corrections services, for**  
9 **the period 7/1/23 through 6/30/25, in an amount not to exceed \$2,691,940.00, for the**  
10 **Executive’s Department of Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.**

11  
12 WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction (ODRC)  
13 previously awarded Community Corrections Act (CCA) 407 and 408 program grants, to support  
14 housing and alternative community corrections programming for felony and misdemeanor  
15 offenders; a Targeted Community Alternatives to Prison (TCAP) grant, to assist in housing felony  
16 4 and 5 offenders locally, in lieu of transferring them to state prison; and a Justice Reinvestment  
17 and Incentive Grant (JRIG), which provides programming to offenders to reduce recidivism; and  
18

19 WHEREAS, ODRC has combined these grant programs for the two-year grant cycle for  
20 State Fiscal Years 2024 – 2025 into a Community Corrections Act 2.0 grant; and  
21

22 WHEREAS, under the CCA 2.0 grant program, ODRC awarded a grant in the amount of  
23 \$7,597,903.00 to the County of Summit, for the period 7/1/23 through 6/30/25, with no local cash  
24 match requirement, to support maintaining offenders locally and being able to provide alternative  
25 community corrections housing and programming; and

27 WHEREAS, this grant funding is provided to the Court of Common Pleas for the Intensive  
28 Supervised Probation program and court assessments; the Sheriff’s Office for costs associated with  
29 the management and housing individuals locally in lieu of prison; and Oriana House, Inc., which  
30 currently provides community corrections services; and

32 WHEREAS, Oriana House, Inc. is a Best Practical Source pursuant to Sections  
33 177.01(h)(4)D. and 177.07(a)(5) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit as they  
34 currently provide similar community corrections services under the Community Corrections Act  
35 grant 407 and 408 contracts previously adopted by this Council (Resolution Nos. 2021-219,  
36 2021-220 and 2022-120, respectively), as well as the general fund, which was subject to the  
37 Request for Proposal process; and

39 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 21, 2023, awarded a  
40 professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for community  
41 corrections services, for the period 7/1/23 through 6/30/25, in an amount not to exceed  
42 \$2,691,940.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and  
43

44 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information,  
45 that the aforementioned professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc. is necessary and in  
46 the best interest of the County of Summit;

48 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

6 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana House,  
7 Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for community corrections services, for the period 7/1/23 through  
8 6/30/25, in an amount not to exceed \$2,691,940.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is  
9 hereby authorized to execute such professional service contract.

11 SECTION 2

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13 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
14 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
15 continue to provide community corrections services without interruption, effective 7/1/23.

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19 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect  
20 immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and  
21 be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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25 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
26 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
27 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were

29 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
