A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a Temporary Assistance to Needy Families Agreement with Akron Community Service Center & Urban League, Inc., to provide Scholars Academy program services for 9th through 12th grade students, for a one-year term, from 7/1/23 through 6/30/24, in an amount not to exceed \$150,000.00, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Executive's Department of Jobs and Family Services, seeks to enter an agreement with Akron Community Service Center & Urban League, Inc. to provide Scholars Academy program services for 9th through 12th grade students; and

WHEREAS, the Scholars Academy program is designed to prepare students for college and careers through training and learning experiences that expand opportunities to attend college and identify career paths that they may not have considered. Services provided will include college preparation courses and learning experiences, ACT/SAT preparation, college tours/fairs, college applications/essays, financial aid, workforce development training (mentoring, internships, interviewing/resume building, career path/trade understanding) and entrepreneurship training (business development, business operations training, business tours); and

WHEREAS, high school seniors that fully participate in the Scholars Academy will be eligible to receive a scholarship at the end of the program year, which is offered through other funding not associated with this contract; and

WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to enter into an agreement with Akron Community Service Center & Urban League, Inc., for the aforementioned program; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 21, 2023, awarded a TANF Agreement with Akron Community Service Center & Urban League, Inc., which is exempt from competitive bidding due to the provider's subgrantee status, to provide Scholars Academy program services for 9th through 12th grade students, for a one-year term, from 7/1/23 through 6/30/24, in an amount not to exceed \$150,000.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned TANF Agreement with Akron Community Service Center & Urban League, Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of a Temporary Assistance to Needy Families ("TANF") Agreement with Akron Community Service Center & Urban League, Inc., to provide Scholars Academy program services for 9th through 12th grade students, for a one-year term, from 7/1/23 through 6/30/24, in an amount not to exceed \$150,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said agreement and any necessary related documents.
