7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a professional service**
8 **contract with CourtView Justice Solutions, Inc. dba equivalent, as a Sole Source, for system**
9 **software, for a five-year term, from 1/1/24 through 12/31/28, with one option to renew for**
10 **an additional five-year term, in a total amount not to exceed \$453,585.00, for the Court of**
11 **Common Pleas-Probate Division, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas-Probate Division uses CourtView Justice
14 Solutions, Inc. dba equivalent for its system software, which includes case management, financial
15 management, judicial management, eAccess and OnBase imaging and upgrades; and

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17 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2018-445, which authorized
18 the execution of a professional service contract with CourtView Justice Solutions, Inc. dba
19 equivalent, as a Sole Source, for system software, for a five-year term, from 1/1/19 through
20 12/31/23, in an amount not to exceed \$400,504.00; and

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22 WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas-Probate Division wishes to have the Executive
23 execute the aforementioned professional service contract as a Sole Source as it is the current
24 system in place and uses proprietary software; and

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26 WHEREAS, the cost for the five-year term of the professional service contract will be an
27 amount not to exceed \$86,292.00 for year one, an amount not to exceed \$88,449.00 for year two,
28 an amount not to exceed \$90,662.00 for year three, an amount not to exceed \$92,929.00 for year
29 four and an amount not to exceed \$95,253.00 for year five, for a total amount not to exceed
30 \$453,585.00; and

32 WHEREAS, the Board of Control at its meeting held on August 16, 2023, awarded a
33 professional service contract with CourtView Justice Solutions, Inc. dba equivalent, as a Sole
34 Source, approved by the Information Technology Board on August 4, 2023, for system software,
35 for a five-year term, from 1/1/24 through 12/31/28, with one option to renew for an additional
36 five-year term, in an amount not to exceed \$453,585.00, subject to confirmation by this Council;

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39 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
40 that the aforementioned professional service contract with CourtView Justice Solutions, Inc. dba
41 equivalent is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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43 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
44 State of Ohio, that:

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46 SECTION 1

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48 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with CourtView
49 Justice Solutions, Inc. dba equivalent, as a Sole Source, for system software, for a five-year term,
50 from 1/1/24 through 12/31/28, with one option to renew for an additional five-year term, in a
51 total amount not to exceed \$453,585.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby
52 authorized to execute said contract and any other necessary related documents.

6 This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency in the interest of the health, safety
7 and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it is
8 necessary to immediately provide necessary software and support to the Court of Common
9 Pleas-Probate Division.

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13 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
14 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
15 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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17 SECTION 4

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19 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
20 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
21 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in
22 meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of
23 the Ohio Revised Code.
