7 **A Resolution, pursuant to Section 177.13 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**
8 **Summit, authorizing purchases by the Sheriff as a Best Practical Source, in calendar year**
9 **2023, with Akron Uniforms for Sheriff Deputy uniform purchases, in an aggregate amount**
10 **not to exceed \$200,000, Akron Automotive, LLC. for fleet repair services, in an aggregate**
11 **amount not to exceed \$150,000, Conrad’s Tire Service for fleet repair services, in an**
12 **aggregate amount not to exceed \$70,000.00, and Williams Automotive, LLC. for fleet**
13 **repair services, in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$100,000.00, for the Sheriff’s Office,**
14 **and declaring an emergency.**

15

16 WHEREAS, Section 177.13 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
17 requires that purchases by an officeholder exceeding \$50,000.00 in the aggregate in any calendar
18 year, where no additional competitive quotes or bids have been taken, shall be made only upon
19 authorization of this Council; and

20

21 WHEREAS, the Board of Control previously approved a blanket encumbrance for
22 various vendors for uniform allowance costs, per the Collective Bargaining Agreement between
23 the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc. and the Summit County Sheriff’s Office,
24 providing each Sheriff Deputy with an allowance of \$1,900.00, at its meeting held March 15,
25 2023 in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00 per vendor for a total amount not to exceed
26 \$205,00000;

28 WHEREAS, the Board of Control previously approved a general encumbrance for
29 various vendors for fleet repair services at its meeting held on March 29, 2023 in an amount not
30 to exceed \$50,000.00 per vendor for a total amount not to exceed \$200,000.00 and

31

32 WHEREAS, it is necessary to exceed an aggregate of \$50,000 in disbursements to the
33 aforementioned vendors in 2023; and

35 WHEREAS, uniform purchase by deputies from Akron Uniforms have exceeded
36 historical usage and the expected amount for 2023; and

38 WHEREAS, due to inflation and a lack of available parts, vehicle repair costs have
39 significantly increased, therefore the Sheriff’s Office is projected to spend more with Akron
40 Automotive, LLC., Conrad’s Tire Service, and Williams Automotive, LLC. than expected; and

42 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information
43 that, subject to an award by the Board of Control, that it is necessary and in the best interest of
44 the County to authorize purchases by the Sheriff from Akron Uniforms for Sheriff Deputy
45 uniform purchases, in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$200,000, Akron Automotive, LLC. for
46 fleet repair services, in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$150,000, Conrad’s Tire Service for
47 fleet repair services, in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$70,000.00, and Williams
48 Automotive, LLC. for fleet repair services, in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$100,000.00;

50 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
51 of Ohio, that:

4 SECTION 1

5

6 This Council hereby authorizes purchases by the Sheriff from Akron Uniforms for Sheriff
7 Deputy uniform purchases, in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$200,000, Akron Automotive,
8 LLC. for fleet repair services, in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$150,000, Conrad's Tire
9 Service for fleet repair services, in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$70,000.00, and Williams
10 Automotive, LLC. for fleet repair services, in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$100,000.00,
11 and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said purchase contracts and any other
12 necessary related documents.

14 SECTION 2

15

16 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
17 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
18 authorize necessary purchases for continued operations within the Sheriff's Office in calendar
19 year 2023.

21 SECTION 3

23 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
24 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
25 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

27 SECTION 4

29 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
30 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
31 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
32 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
33 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


