RESOLUTION NO. 2023-286 PAGE TWO WHEREAS, Power A Clean Future Ohio assists in facilitating technical assistance for the implementation of these carbon reduction policies; and WHEREAS, the County has enacted energy-reducing policies and legislation since 2021, including the approval of the Summit County Lighting Upgrade Project that increased energy efficiency and lowered maintenance costs by updating lighting fixtures in 12 County Buildings with energy efficient LED lights, and the usage of electronic signature software that has saved hundreds of thousands of pieces of paper; and WHEREAS, the County seeks to use its partnership with Power A Clean Future Ohio to build upon past sustainability efforts, leverage funding opportunities for carbon reduction and encourage residents to engage in the climate conversation; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that: **SECTION 1** The County of Summit joins in participating in the Power A Clean Future Ohio coalition. **SECTION 2** The County of Summit pledges to assess our opportunities to reduce carbon emissions within the Executive's Office operations and future projects. **SECTION 3** The County plans to achieve this goal through strategic, cost-effective efforts, including increasing the number of publicly accessible electric vehicle charging stations, mandating electronic signatures within the Executive's Office, and exploring other sustainable options as it pertains to current operations and future County projects with Power A Clean Future Ohio's technical assistance. **SECTION 4** This Resolution appoints Greta Johnson to serve as the County's Power A Clean Future Ohio coordinator for implementation and the Summit County Environmental Sustainability Task Force as the County's Power A Clean Future Ohio coordination team.
