7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
8 **the Community Drug Board, Inc. dba CHC Addiction Services, Inc., as a Best Practical**
9 **Source, for drug screen testing services, from 3/1/23 through 2/28/24, in an amount not to**
10 **exceed \$121,000.00, for the Court of Common Pleas-General Division, Adult Probation**
11 **Department, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas-General Division, Adult Probation Department
14 (the “Court”) has used Community Drug Board, Inc. dba CHC Addiction Services, Inc. (“CHC”)
15 to drug test adult probationers for a number of years; and

16

17 WHEREAS, in addition to their lengthy relationship with the Court, CHC is a Best
18 Practical Source pursuant to Sections 177.01(h)(4)D. and 177.07(a)(5) of the Codified
19 Ordinances of the County of Summit because CHC provides the most extensive and observed
20 drug testing in Summit County as well as providing convenient location and hours for easy
21 access by probationers; and

23 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on August 30, 2023, awarded a
24 purchase contract with the CHC, as a Best Practical Source, for drug screen testing services,
25 from 3/1/23 through 2/28/24, in an amount not to exceed \$121,000.00; and

27 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
28 that the aforementioned purchase contract with CHC is necessary and in the best interest of the
29 County of Summit;

31 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
32 of Ohio, that:

36 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with the Community Drug
37 Board, Inc. dba CHC Addiction Services, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for drug screen testing
38 services, from 3/1/23 through 2/28/24, in an amount not to exceed \$121,000.00, is hereby
39 confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said purchase contract and any
40 other necessary related documents.

44 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
45 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
46 provide necessary drug screen testing services for the Court of Common Pleas-General Division,
47 Adult Probation Department.
