7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to enter into a Cooperative Agreement with the**
8 **City of Barberton to improve Wooster Road West, located in the City of Barberton, in**
9 **Council District 7, in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.00 in County funds, for the**
10 **Executive and Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

11

12 WHEREAS, the City of Barberton in cooperation with the Ohio Department of
13 Transportation (“ODOT”) has developed and funded a project on Wooster Road West to reduce
14 the four through lanes to two through lanes and a two-way left turn lane and add wider sidewalks
15 to increase pedestrian safety (the “Project”); and

16

17 WHEREAS, the proposed improvement crosses two Summit County owned bridges
18 SUM-11-0270 (over Hudson Run) and SUM-10-0361 (over Wolf Creek) that need to be
19 rehabilitated to accommodate the reduced pavement width and increased sidewalk width; and

20

21 WHEREAS the total cost of the project is estimated to be \$8,991,351.90 and the
22 County’s cost is not to exceed \$250,000.00; and

24 WHEREAS, it is necessary for the parties to execute an intergovernmental agreement to
25 set forth the rights and duties of the parties concerning the design and construction of the Project,
26 as detailed in Exhibit A, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully
27 restated; and

29 WHEREAS, the City of Barberton will administer the Project; and

30

31 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
32 that the acceptance and approval of the Project is necessary and in the best interest of the County
33 of Summit;

35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
36 of Ohio, that;

38 SECTION 1

40 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute an agreement of cooperation with the City
41 of Barberton to outline responsibilities and financial contributions for the Wooster Road West
42 Improvement Project, located in the City of Barberton, Council District 7, in an amount not to
43 exceed \$250,000.00 in County funds. A copy of said agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit A
44 and incorporated fully herein, with such modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of
45 the provisions of said Cooperative Agreement and not substantially adverse to the County, all of
46 which shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution thereof by the Executive

50 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
51 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately
52 facilitates safety improvements in the City of Barberton, in Council District 7.
