7 **A Resolution authorizing various service rates to be charged by the Sheriff and authorizing**
8 **the Executive to execute contracts for the Sheriff for said services, for calendar years 2024,**
9 **2025, and 2026, for the Executive and the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, the Summit County Sheriff’s Office has historically provided various
12 services to various public and private entities, including patrol services, security and traffic
13 services and the use of the Sheriff’s firing ranges; and

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15 WHEREAS, the County wishes to utilize the service rate schedule, which is referenced
16 below, for these various services for calendar years 2024, 2025 and 2026; and

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18 WHEREAS, this Council last authorized the fee schedule for use of the firing range at the
19 Sheriff Robert D. Campbell Training Facility on December 8, 2020 in Resolution No. 2020-399;
20 and

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22 WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Sections 505.43 and 737.04, the Sheriff has
23 authority to provide policing services by contract to Summit County townships and municipal
24 corporations including both cities and villages; and

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26 WHEREAS, this Council has determined that the Executive should be authorized to
27 execute contracts for the Sheriff for any of these various services at the rates contained herein;
28 and

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30 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
31 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the various
32 service rates to be charged by the Sheriff for calendar years 2024, 2025 and 2026, and
33 authorizing the Executive to execute contracts for said services;

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35 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

7 documents, for services provided by the Sheriff, at the service rates contained in Section 1.

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11 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
12 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
13 authorize various service rates to be charged by the Sheriff and to authorize the Executive to
14 execute service contracts for services provided by the Sheriff and any necessary related
15 documents.

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17 SECTION 3

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19 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
20 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
21 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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23 SECTION 4

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25 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
26 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
27 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,

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


