7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to advertise for separate bids for the Exterior**
8 **Lighting Project and Paving Construction Project, for the Summit County Children**
9 **Services Administration Building, located in the City of Akron, in Council District 4, for**
10 **estimated total costs not to exceed \$90,000.00 and \$154,000.00, respectively, for the**
11 **Executive’s Department of Administrative Services–Physical Plants, and declaring an**
12 **emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the Administration Building for Summit County Children Services
15 (“SCCS”), located at 264 S Arlington St, Akron, Ohio, in Council District 4, was built in 1996;
16 and

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18 WHEREAS, the Administrative Building’s exterior lighting is the original lighting from
19 its construction and the Exterior Lighting Project will replace all existing lights with energy
20 efficient and long lasting LED lights; and

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22 WHEREAS, the SCCS Administration Building’s parking lot was installed in 1996 and
23 has only had patch repairs and sealcoating done to it since that time. The Paving Construction
24 Project would grind and overlay the rear parking lot dramatically improving it. The front
25 parking lot was completed earlier this year; and

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27 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to undertake both the Exterior Lighting Project and
28 Paving Construction Project to improve and prolong the serviceability of the SCCS
29 Administration Building; and

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31 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
32 requires this Council’s authorization for the Executive to advertise for bids; and

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34 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to advertise for bids for the aforementioned Exterior
35 Lighting Project, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$90,000.00, and the aforementioned
36 Paving Construction Project, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$154,000.00; and

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38 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specifications for each project is on file in the Clerk of
39 Council’s Office; and

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41 WHEREAS, this Council will also review and award separate contracts for each of the
42 above listed projects; and

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44 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
45 that is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
46 advertise for bids for the Exterior Lighting Project, for estimated total costs not to exceed
47 \$90,000.00, and for the Paving Construction Project for an estimated total cost not to exceed
48 \$154,000.00;

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50 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

6 The Executive is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the Exterior Lighting
7 Project, for the Summit County Children Services ("SCCS") Administration Building, located in
8 the City of Akron, in District 4, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$90,000.00.

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10 SECTION 2

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12 The Executive is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the Paving Construction
13 Project, for the SCCS Administration Building, located in the City of Akron, in District 4, for an
14 estimated total cost not to exceed \$154,000.00.

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16 SECTION 3

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18 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
19 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the
20 Executive to immediately advertisement for bids for necessary improvements at the SCCS
21 Administration Building.

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23 SECTION 4

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25 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
26 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
27 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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29 SECTION 5

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31 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
32 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
33 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were
34 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
35 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


