A Resolution authorizing employee retention lump sum payments to eligible non-bargaining employees of the Sheriff's Office pursuant to a subgrant received from the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services to promote recruitment and retention of law enforcement employees, in accordance with the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, for the purpose of assisting with employee retention, for the Executive and Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office was awarded a subgrant from the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services, in accordance with the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, in the amount of \$2,918,249.69, from April 1, 2022 to April 30, 2024, with \$1,971,852.00 allocated to provide a lump sum equal to ten percent (10%) of certain eligible employees' yearly salary in order to promote recruitment and retention of employees in the law enforcement field, with \$196,869.60 allocated for Deputy Sheriff Cadets' wages; and

WHEREAS, certain classified and unclassified non-bargaining employees in the Sheriff's Office are eligible to receive said lump sums, the classifications of whom are listed along with the amount of the expected lump sum based on ten percent (10%) of their yearly salaries in Exhibit A to this Resolution, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated fully herein; and

WHEREAS, the retention bonuses will be paid as a lump sum that is not eligible for an Ohio Public Employees Retirement System (OPERS) contribution, in one installment on or about December 1, 2023, at a rate of ten percent (10%) of the eligible employees' current salaries; and

WHEREAS, this Council's approval is required in order to pay said lump sums; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the retention bonus payments are necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

In accordance with the subgrant from the Ohio Department of Public Safety, retention bonuses will be paid as a lump sum that is not eligible for an Ohio Public Employees Retirement System (OPERS) contribution, in one installment, on or about December 1, 2023, at a rate of ten percent (10%) of the eligible non-bargaining employees' current salaries, totaling the amounts listed in Exhibit A to this Resolution, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated fully herein.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
