SCOPE OF SERVICES

- 1. Physician Services at the facility including direct medical care and triage services three times per week on such days and during such hours as the parties agree. Personnel will be reasonably available for telephone consultation as needed. Psychiatric services at the facility two hours per week, on such days and during such hours as the parties agree.
- Provide and oversee nursing coverage 13.5 hours per day, 7:00 am. to 8:30 p.m., 7 days per week. RN coverage shall consist of 40 hours per week onsite. The balance of coverage will be provided by RN/LPN coverage with RN availability for consultation 7 days per week. RN staffing should reflect the census needs at the detention center; thereby, meeting the needs of the youth as best as possible.

Nursing coverage, in the case of illness, vacation, holidays, etc., shall be provided by healthcare provider to ensure continuity of care. Staffing issues, including hours of coverage, are the sole responsibility of the healthcare provider in collaboration with the physician.

The RN/LPN staff should have a working knowledge and experience with adolescent healthcare needs and adolescent development.

The RN staff should also have a working knowledge of community resources for youth, including such services as BCMH, Summit County Drug Board and mental health facilities and access to secondary and tertiary healthcare facilities.

All RN's and LPN's licenses must reflect medication coverage to assist in the distribution of prescribed medications.
