A Resolution authorizing the Executive to advertise for bids for the construction of Project Q-166 Pump Station #36 Replacement and Force Main Improvements, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$2,672,000.00, and to authorize the Executive to apply for and execute a Cooperative Agreement with the Ohio Water Development Authority for a loan in an amount not to exceed \$2,672,000.00 to fund the project, located in the City of Hudson, in Council District 3, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to construct a new pump station and install a new force main to replace the existing Pump Station #36, that is failing due to the age of the facilities, for Project Q-166 Pump #36 Replacement and Force Main Improvements (the "Q-166 Project"), located in

the City of Hudson, in Council District 3; and 19

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2017-296, which authorized the Executive to execute a professional services contract for professional design services for the Q-166 Project; and

WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to advertise for bids for the construction of the Q-166 Project for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$2,672,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinance of the County of Summit requires this Council's authorization for the Executive to advertise for bids for construction contracts in excess of \$50,000.00; and

WHEREAS, copies of the plans and specifications for the Q-166 Project are on file with the Clerk of Council; and

WHEREAS, the Executive intends to apply for an Ohio Water Development Authority ("OWDA") loan to fund the Q-166 Project, for a 20-year loan term, in an amount not to exceed \$2,672,000.00; and

WHEREAS, OWDA requires the legislative authority of the County to adopt legislation for the application of loans, the execution of agreements and the designation of repayment sources; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to advertise for bids for the construction of the Q-166 Project for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$2,672,000.00 and apply for and execute a Cooperative Agreement with the OWDA for loan to fund the Q-166 Project in an amount not to exceed \$2,672,000.00 and designate repayment from the Sanitary Sewer Enterprise Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

4 SECTION 1 5

The Executive is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the construction of Project Q-166 Pump Station #36 Replacement and Force Main Improvements (the "Q-166 Project") located in the City of Hudson, in Council District 3, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$2,672,000.00.

## **SECTION 2**

 The Executive is hereby authorized to apply for and execute a Cooperative Agreement with the Ohio Water Development Authority for a loan, with a term of 20 years, in an amount not to exceed \$2,672,000.00, to fund the Q-166 Project, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, with such modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of the loan agreement and not substantially adverse to the County, and any other necessary documents related to the loan. This Council further designates the Sanitary Sewer Enterprise Fund as the dedicated source of repayment for the Ohio Water Development Authority loan.

## **SECTION 3**

This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately advertise for bids for the construction of the Q-166 Project and execute a necessary agreement and loan document so that the project may proceed in a timely manner.

## **SECTION 4**

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 5**

It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
