A Resolution declaring the failure in the gravity main sewer caused by sewer line breaks on Gorge Park Boulevard, located in the City of Stow, in Council District 3, an emergency pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, and confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Wingfoot Rental & Development Co., in an amount not to exceed \$178,169.11, for an emergency repair to the gravity main sewer, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, due to the failure in the gravity main sewer, emergency repairs were required to repair the sewer line breaks in the 20 inch gravity main sewer that included three broken lateral connections, in the gorge south of Gorge Park Boulevard and east of Patty Ann Drive, located in the City of Stow, in Council District 3; and

WHEREAS, Wingfoot Rental & Development Co. was directed to make the emergency repairs based on their expertise, availability and performance on similar projects; and

WHEREAS, the above referenced circumstances made it necessary for the County to utilize Wingfoot Rental & Development Co. for an emergency repair of the gravity main sewer on Gorge Park Boulevard, located in the City of Stow, in Council District 3, to be returned to normal operations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on October 11, 2023, awarded a construction contract with Wingfoot Rental & Development Co. for an emergency repair of said gravity main sewer, in an amount not to exceed \$178,169.11, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned repairs constitute an emergency repair under Section 177.07(a)(3) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit and further finds and determines that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to confirm the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Wingfoot Rental & Development Co. for said emergency repair of the gravity main sewer, in an amount not to exceed \$178,169.11;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
