7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract**
8 **with Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and one**
9 **full-time recovery support specialist, to provide support and treatment services to Valor**
10 **Court participants, for a one-year term, from 9/30/23 through 9/29/24, in an amount not to**
11 **exceed \$201,490.00, for the Court of Common Pleas-General Division, Adult Probation, and**
12 **declaring an emergency.**

14 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2020-091, which confirmed
15 the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., as a
16 Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and one full-time recovery support
17 specialist, to provide support and treatment services to Valor Court participants, for a one-year
18 term, from 9/30/19 through 9/29/20, in an amount not to exceed \$210,332.00; and

20 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2021-015, which
21 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana House,
22 Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and one full-time recovery support
23 specialist, to provide support and treatment services to Valor Court participants, for a one-year
24 term, from 9/30/20 through 9/29/21, in an amount not to exceed \$216,388.49; and

26 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2021-277, which
27 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana House,
28 Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and one full-time recovery support
29 specialist, to provide support and treatment services to Valor Court participants, for a one-year
30 term, from 9/30/21 through 9/29/22, in an amount not to exceed \$216,388.49; and

32 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2022-339, which
33 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana House,
34 Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and one full-time recovery support
35 specialist, to provide support and treatment services to Valor Court participants, for a one-year
36 term, from 9/30/22 through 9/29/23, in an amount not to exceed \$229,183.00; and

38 WHEREAS, based on performance reviews and Oriana House Inc.'s specialized
39 knowledge and previous years working with the Valor Court, the Court of Common Pleas-General
40 Division, Adult Probation, wishes to enter into a professional service contract with Oriana House,
41 Inc., as a Best Practical Source pursuant to Sections 177.01(h)(4)D. and 177.07(a)(5) of the
42 Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, for a one-year term, from 9/30/23 through 9/29/24,
43 in an amount not to exceed \$201,490.00, to be funded by a no cost extension for Fiscal Year 2023
44 Treatment Drug Courts grant from the United States Department of Health and Human Services,
45 Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration ("SAMSHA") for the Valor Court
46 Expansion and Enhancement Project; and

48 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held November 29, 2023, awarded said
49 professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for a one-year
50 term, from 9/30/23 through 9/29/24, in an amount not to exceed \$201,490.00, subject to
51 confirmation by this Council; and

5 that the aforementioned renewal of the professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc. is
6 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
9 of Ohio, that;

13 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Oriana House,
14 Inc., as a Best Practical Source, for two full-time case managers and one full-time recovery support
15 specialist, to provide support and treatment services to Valor Court participants, for a one-year
16 term, from 9/30/23 through 9/29/24, in an amount not to exceed \$201,490.00, is hereby
17 confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said professional service contract and
18 any other necessary related documents.

22 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
23 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately authorizes
24 necessary support and treatment services for Valor Court participants.

28 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect
29 immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and
30 be in force at the earliest time provided by law.




