A Resolution declaring the month of March 2024 as Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month in Summit County, recognizing people with developmental disabilities for their contributions to our community and their perseverance in breaking down barriers, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the National Association of Councils on Developmental Disabilities celebrates March as Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month with an annual campaign to raise awareness and increase the inclusion of people with developmental disabilities in all areas of life, with the intention to highlight the barriers that inhibit people with developmental disabilities from connecting to the communities in which they live; and

WHEREAS, it is important to recognize that the inclusion of people with developmental disabilities creates strong, diverse communities where all residents are welcomed and valued; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Developmental Disabilities Council and the Summit County Developmental Disabilities Board (“Summit DD”) participate in Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month by hosting events and initiatives; and

WHEREAS, these events include Inclusion Day on March 4, 2024, on which Summit DD celebrates by turning Summit County orange through clothes, stickers, signs, and social media posts, and Inclusion Day at the Zoo, where the Akron Zoo partners with Summit DD to offer free admission to visitors who wear orange between March 2 through March 4; and

WHEREAS, it is beneficial to promote these events so that residents of Summit County are encouraged to participate and do their part in promoting an inclusive community; and
