7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a Temporary Assistance to**  
8 **Needy Families agreement with Emmanuel Christian Academy for Entrepreneurship**  
9 **Summer Camp Services, from 4/1/24 through 9/30/24, in an amount not to exceed**  
10 **\$100,000.00, for the Executive’s Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an**  
11 **emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2021-205, which amended a  
14 Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (“TANF”) agreement with Emmanuel Christian  
15 Academy for Entrepreneurship Summer Camp Services, from 5/1/21 through 8/30/21, to  
16 increase the total not to exceed amount to \$128,225.24; and

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18 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2022-042, which  
19 awarded a TANF agreement with Emmanuel Christian Academy for Entrepreneurship Summer  
20 Camp Services, from 5/1/22 through 8/30/22, in an not to exceed amount to \$100,000.00; and

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22 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2023-060, which  
23 awarded a TANF agreement with Emmanuel Christian Academy for Entrepreneurship Summer  
24 Camp Services, from 5/1/23 through 8/30/23, in an not to exceed amount to \$100,000.00; and

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26 WHEREAS, pursuant to the TANF agreement, Emmanuel Christian Academy provided  
27 entrepreneurship summer camp services which introduce students to self-sufficiency though  
28 development of business opportunities and life skills; and

30 WHEREAS, the services are offered to youth aged 9 to 15 years old via classroom  
31 workshops, guest speakers, group projects and field trips; and cover a range of training topics;  
32 and

34 WHEREAS, due to the continued success of the program, the Executive wishes to enter  
35 into a new TANF agreement with Emmanuel Christian Academy to provide the above referenced  
36 services from 4/1/24 through 9/30/24, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00; and

38 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held February 28, 2024, awarded a  
39 TANF agreement with Emmanuel Christian Academy, which is exempt from competitive  
40 bidding due to the provider’s subgrantee status, for Entrepreneurship Summer Camp Services,  
41 from 4/1/24 through 9/30/24, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00, subject to the approval of  
42 this Council; and

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44 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
45 that the aforementioned TANF agreement with Emmanuel Christian Academy is necessary and  
46 in the best interest of the County of Summit;

6 The award by the Board of Control, of a Temporary Assistance to Needy Families  
7 ("TANF") agreement with Emmanuel Christian Academy to provide for Entrepreneurship  
8 Summer Camp Services, from 4/1/24 through 9/30/24, in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00,  
9 is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said agreement and any  
10 other necessary related documents.

12 SECTION 2

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14 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety, and  
15 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
16 confirm the award of a TANF agreement in order to immediately provide additional  
17 Entrepreneurship Summer Camp Services to local youth.

19 SECTION 3

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21 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
22 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
23 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
