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7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with**
8 **the City of Twinsburg concerning the resurfacing of Liberty Road, located in the City of**
9 **Twinsburg, the City of Reminderville, and Twinsburg Township, in Council District 1, for**
10 **the Executive and Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the Engineer has determined Liberty Road from Cannon Road to 100 feet
13 south of Post Road, located in the City of Twinsburg, the City of Reminderville, and Twinsburg
14 Township, in Council District 1, is in need of resurfacing (the “Project”); and

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16 WHEREAS, the City of Twinsburg has secured federal Surface Transportation Black
17 Grant funds in the amount of \$700,00.00 for the construction of the Project; and

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19 WHEREAS, approximately 82% of the paved surface is located in the City of Twinsburg
20 and 18% of the paved surface is in Twinsburg Township; and

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22 WHEREAS, the City of Twinsburg has agreed to take the lead on the Project; and

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24 WHEREAS, it is necessary for the parties to execute an intergovernmental agreement to
25 set forth the rights and duties of the parties concerning the design and construction of the Project,
26 as detailed in Exhibit A, a copy of which is attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein as
27 if fully restated; and

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29 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
30 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to enter
31 into an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Twinsburg for the aforementioned Project;

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33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
34 of Ohio, that;

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36 SECTION 1

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38 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the
39 City of Twinsburg to outline responsibilities and financial contributions for the Liberty Road
40 Resurfacing Project. The final agreement will be substantially in the same form as the agreement
41 attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully restated, with such modifications
42 and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of said intergovernmental agreement
43 and not substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively evidenced by the
44 execution thereof by the Executive.

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46 SECTION 2

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48 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
49 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately
50 allow the Executive to execute said agreement and allow the City of Twinsburg and the Engineer
51 to proceed with a needed road improvement.

9 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
