7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with**
8 **the City of Twinsburg concerning the Glenwood Drive Bridge Replacement Project,**
9 **located in the City of Twinsburg, in Council District 1, for the Executive and Engineer, and**
10 **declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the Engineer has determined the Glenwood Drive Bridge over Tinkers
13 Creek, located in the City of Twinsburg, in Council District 1, is in need of replacement (the
14 “Project”); and

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16 WHEREAS, the Engineer has secured Local Bridge Replacement funds programmed
17 through the County Engineer’s Association of Ohio, in the amount of \$2,602,160.00 for the
18 construction of the Project; and

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20 WHEREAS, the City of Twinsburg has requested permission to widen the walkway on
21 the structure, include aesthetic treatment to the bridge parapet, to install decorative lighting on
22 the bridge, and to use the bridge to support a city-owned waterline; and

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24 WHEREAS, it is necessary for the parties to execute an intergovernmental agreement to
25 set forth the rights and duties of the parties concerning the design and construction of the Project,
26 as detailed in Exhibit A, a copy of which is attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein as
27 if fully restated; and

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29 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
30 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to enter
31 into an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Twinsburg for the aforementioned Project;

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33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
34 of Ohio, that;

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36 SECTION 1

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38 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the
39 City of Twinsburg to outline responsibilities and financial contributions for the Glenwood Drive
40 Bridge Replacement Project. The final agreement will be substantially in the same form as the
41 agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully restated, with such
42 modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of said intergovernmental
43 agreement and not substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively
44 evidenced by the execution thereof by the Executive.

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46 SECTION 2

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48 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
49 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately
50 allow the Executive to execute said agreement and allow the City of Twinsburg and the Engineer
51 to proceed with a needed bridge replacement.

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4 SECTION 3

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6 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
7 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
8 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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10 SECTION 4

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12 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
13 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
14 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
15 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
16 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
