7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control, subject to the approval of the**  
8 **Information Technology Board, of a purchase contract with Insight Public Sector Inc., at**  
9 **less than State Term Pricing, for updated computer equipment, in an amount not to exceed**  
10 **\$303,904.86, for the Office of Information Technology, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, the Office of Information Technology periodically undertakes equipment  
13 refreshes and is currently refreshing laptop and desktop computers; and

14

15 WHEREAS, the Office of Information Technology recommends the purchase of 165  
16 Lenovo ThinkPad Docking stations, 165 Lenovo Notebook ThinkPad laptops, and 87 Desktops  
17 to replace aging equipment; and

19 WHEREAS, this contract is exempt from competitive bidding under Section 177.07(a)(7)  
20 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit as the cost is less than State Term pricing;  
21 and

23 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on March 20, 2024, awarded a  
24 purchase contract, subject to approval of the Information Technology Board, with Insight Public  
25 Sector Inc., at less than State Term Pricing, for updated computer equipment, in an amount not to  
26 exceed \$303,904.86, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

28 WHEREAS, the Information Technology Board, at its meeting to be held on April 11,  
29 2024, will consider the aforementioned contract for approval; and

31 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
32 that the aforementioned purchase contract with Insight Public Sector Inc., subject to the approval  
33 of the Information Technology Board, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of  
34 Summit;

36 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

44 and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said purchase contract and any other necessary  
45 related documents.

51 providing necessary equipment for the Office of Information Technology.
