7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a renewal (first of two) of a**  
8 **professional service contract with Davey Resource Group, Inc. for the evaluation and**  
9 **vegetation cleaning on detention and retention ponds located within assessed Township**  
10 **subdivisions located in Council Districts 1, 4, and 5, for an amount not to exceed**  
11 **\$95,000.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Engineer determined that evaluation, planning, and performance of  
14 various aquatic vegetation eradication, general maintenance, and adjunct services on an as-  
15 needed basis at storm water management facilities (“SWMFs”) in Drainage Maintenance District  
16 1 for various future County projects are needed for the welfare of the public; and

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18 WHEREAS, Drainage Maintenance District 1 includes the townships of Bath in Districts  
19 4 and 5, Richfield, Boston, Sagamore Hills, Northfield Center, and Twinsburg in Council District  
20 1; and

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22 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2023-142, confirming the  
23 award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Davey Resource Group,  
24 Inc. for the evaluation and vegetation cleaning on detention and retention ponds located within  
25 assessed Township subdivisions located in Council Districts 1, 4, and 5, with two options to  
26 renew for an additional one-year term, for an amount not to exceed \$95,000.00; and

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28 WHEREAS, this project is funded by the Assessed Subdivision Fund for District 1 which  
29 property owners in the assessed subdivisions pay into this fund for the perpetual maintenance of  
30 stormwater facilities located within the subdivisions; and

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32 WHEREAS, the Engineer wishes to renew the professional service contract with Davey  
33 Resource Group, Inc. to perform all evaluation, planning, and performance of various aquatic  
34 vegetation eradication, general maintenance, and adjunct services as authorized by the Engineer  
35 at locations as specified among the 90 SWMFs in 66 assessed subdivisions in Drainage  
36 Maintenance District 1; and

38 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held April 17, 2024, awarded a renewal  
39 (first of two) of a professional service contract with Davey Resource Group, Inc. for the  
40 evaluation and vegetation cleaning on detention and retention ponds located within assessed  
41 Township subdivisions located in Council Districts 1, 4, and 5, for a one-year term, for an  
42 amount not to exceed \$95,000.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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44 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
45 that the aforementioned renewal of a professional service contract with Davey Resource Group,  
46 Inc. is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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4 SECTION 1

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6 The award by the Board of Control of a renewal (first of two) of a professional service  
7 contract with Davey Resource Group, Inc. for the evaluation and vegetation cleaning on  
8 detention and retention ponds located within assessed Township subdivisions located in the  
9 Council Districts 1, 4, and 5, for a one-year term, for an amount not to exceed \$95,000.00, is  
10 hereby confirmed, and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said renewal and any other  
11 necessary related documents.

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13 SECTION 2

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15 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and  
16 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will allow the  
17 Engineer's project to commence as expeditiously as possible.

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19 SECTION 3

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21 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
22 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
23 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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25 SECTION 4

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27 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
28 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
29 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
30 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
31 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
