31	WHEREAS, CCMEP services are provided with the goals of assisting at-risk youth	in

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WHEREAS, as required by the CCMEP, this renewal will be funded by both WIOA funding through the SAMWA COG and TANF funding through DJFS, with the TANF allocation being \$1,854,262.85; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to approve the aforementioned renewal of these agreements with the providers listed on Exhibit A;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

## **SECTION 1**

The award by the Board of Control of a renewal (third and final) of agreements between certain providers set forth on Exhibit A, a copy of which is attached hereto as and incorporated fully herein, and the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services and the Summit and Medina Workforce Area Council of Governments to provide in-school and out-of-school youth employment and educational services under the Comprehensive Case Management and Employment Program, for the period of 7/1/24 to 6/30/25, in a total amount not to exceed \$2,576,868.56, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said agreements and any other necessary related documents.

## **SECTION 2**

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide in-school and out-of-school youth employment and educational services effective 7/1/24.

## SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

## **SECTION 4**

 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
