9	calling for the prevention of gun violence by wearing orange, for the Executive, and declaring

12	WHEREAS, 43,142 people died from gun violence in the United States in 2023 according
13	to the Gun Violence Archive, which includes 19,050 homicides and 24,090 suicides; and
14	
15	WHEREAS, mass shootings are defined by the Gun Violence Archive as an incident where
16	at least four people were shot, either injured or killed, not including the shooter; and

18	WHEREAS, the Gun Violence Archive reported 655 mass shootings in 2023 and as of
19	May 1, 2024 the number of mass shootings in the United States outpaced the number of days in
20	the year; and

22	WHEREAS, gun violence in the United States has affected nearly every community, with
23	mass shootings since the last Gun Violence Awareness Day including the October 25, 2024
24	shooting in Lewiston, Maine which killed 18 people and injured 13 others, the February 14, 2024
25	shooting in Kansas City, Missouri which killed one and injured 22 others, including 11 children,
26	during the Super Bowl LVIII victory parade, and the April 29, 2024 shooting in Charlotte, North
27	Carolina which killed four law enforcement officers; and
28	Caronna which knied four law emorcement officers, and
29	WHEREAS, according to a KFF analysis of data from the Centers of Disease Control and

	children aged 1-18 in 2020 and 2021, with preliminary data pointing to similar trends in 2022 and

	WHEDEAC VEE senests the United States has the highest shild and teen fines mountality.
34	WHEREAS, KFF reports the United States has the highest child and teen firearm mortality
35	rate among developed countries at 6.01 deaths per 100,000 among people aged 1-19, with the next
36	highest being Canada at 0.62 deaths per 100,000; and

38	WHEREAS, reporting from the Akron Beacon Journal shows that since 2017, the County
39	has averaged 39 gun-related homicides per year, with over 35 reported in 2023, representing a
40	dramatic increase from an average of less than 20 per year from 2007 through 2016; and
41	
42	WHEREAS, data from Summit County Public Health and an analysis by the Akron Beacon
43	Journal show racial disparities in gun deaths as black residents account for between 74-76% of the
44	County's fatal gunshot wound victims, and black men in Summit County are 19 times more likely
45	to die of gun homicide than white men; and

47	WHEREAS, among the highest responsibilities of elected officials is the obligation to
48	prevent and respond to violence, in this case gun violence, to protect the health and safety of the
